Notes for this January 2025 version of the map:
 Exploration data regarding minerals permits and claim counts have NOT been updated since the 2024 map. Displayed boundary of the proposed withdrawal is approximate.

Roughly 308,890 acres of public lands would be withdrawn from mineral entry under the mining and mineral leasing laws as well as the geothermal leasing laws. The area also encloses an additional ~40,000 acres of "non-federal" (i. e., private) lands.

To be considered, BLM must receive comments on the proposal by April 15, 2025.
